



To minimise the risk of fire and injury when charging batteries, please follow these important safety tips:

- Use only undamaged, original batteries: Always check that the battery is intact and undamaged. Damaged batteries - if swollen, cracked, deformed etc. - can be dangerous and should never be used or charged.
- Use appropriate chargers: Only use chargers designed for your specific product and ensure they are not visibly damaged. Non-original or damaged chargers can cause overheating and fires.
- Charge under supervision: Make sure to charge batteries in a way that allows you to quickly respond if problems arise. A fire in a lithium-ion battery can develop rapidly.
- **4. Install smoke alarms:** Have at least one working smoke alarm in the room where you charge batteries. This can provide early warning in case of smoke or fire.
- 5. Avoid flammable materials: Do not charge batteries near flammable materials such as paper or cleaning alcohol. Ensure there is good ventilation around the charger to prevent overheating.

By following these general guidelines, you can reduce the risk of fire and ensure safer charging of your batteries.

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
